### **Job Description:**

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Act as a diabetes and nutritional resource person for patients
- Participate in the case management of patient care as needed with discharge planning, chart review, patient assessment, and coordination of care with other departments
- Participate and support departmental quality improvement activities and projects
- Demonstrate collaboration and team skills, including the ability to work well with physicians, all disciplines, and staff levels
- Market or promote the Diabetes and Nutrition Center to patients, staff, primary care providers, other community institutions
- Participate in community health functions
- Provide care appropriately to patient population
- Educate patients about diabetes, self-management in the individual or group settings
- Assess patients' self-care needs and his/her ability to manage diabetes

### **Qualifications:**

- Must possess certification from the National Certification Board for Diabetes Educators
- Diabetes Management Certification Preferred
- Experience working with members and providers on Diabetes Education and Medication Therapy Management to optimize medication use required
- Plan and conduct continuing education programs in diabetes for allied professionals and the public
